Many people have heard about the United States Peace Corps founded by President John F. Kennedy.

And quite a few people know someone who has served as a Peace Corps Volunteer in some far-off place overseas.

But few people know exactly what happens during those 27 months of service as a Peace Corps Volunteer in a foreign country.

Independent producer David McDonald recently returned to Grand Rapids, Minnesota after serving as a Peace Corps Volunteer in Morocco from 2012 to 2014.

During his service, he interviewed more than 40 Peace Corps colleagues as well as recorded a fascinating variety of audio from all over Morocco.

The result is a ten-part audio documentary called



This entertaining and thought-provoking series looks at what it means to serve as a Peace Corps Volunteer from the first day of training in Philadelphia to the close of service in Morocco more than two years later.

With a mixture of David's narration, wide-ranging interviews with other volunteers, everyday sounds from Morocco, and loads of different music, 27 *MONTHS* explores whether the Peace Corps is still relevant in the 21st century by looking at the good, the bad, the disappointing, and the fulfilling.



Initial one-day training in Philadelphia and then travel from New York to Morocco.

PART 2 TRAINING Nov. 29

First ten days in country as a Peace Corps Trainee.

PART 3 INTEGRATE Dec. 6

Two months of intense language and culture training while staying with a host family.

PART 4 SWEARING IN Dec. 13

Site assignment and the swearing-in ceremony to become a Peace Corps Volunteer.

PART 5 CULTURE Dec. 20

Living 24/7 in a foreign culture.

PART 6 HOMESICK Dec. 27

Thanksgiving, Christmas, and New Year's Eve as a Peace Corps Volunteer.

PART 7 LOVE Jan. 3

Serving as a married couple, falling in love, coping with loneliness, getting married.

PART 8 UNWANTED Jan. 10

Learning how to deal with new gender roles, unwanted attention, and sexual harassment.

PART 9 TIME Jan. 17

Coming to terms with different ways to treat time.

PART 10 SERVICE Jan. 24

Reflections on serving one's country, international development, and volunteering.
